Signs of Toddlers' Language Delay

12 months	Does not use body gestures (shaking head, waving). Does not practice at least two consonant sounds (d, b).
15 months	Does not say one to three words. Does not say mama or dada.
18 months	Cannot point to body parts. Does not say 6 to 10 words.
20–24 months	Does not make at least six consonant sounds. Does not respond to simple directions. Does not imitate actions or words. Cannot point to named pictures in a book. Cannot join two words in a sentence.
25–30 months	Cannot name three body parts. Cannot speak in a way that is understandable by the family.
30–36 months	Cannot be understood by strangers at least half of the time. Cannot articulate initial consonants in words (all for ball). Cannot name common objects in the home.
