Using a Weebly website you will be regularly making blog posts with pictures of the food you create on the show and explaining how what you've been learning behind the scenes of the show has contributed to your success on it as well as reflecting on what you're going to do better the next time you compete.

WHAT ELSE CAN I INCLUDE?

- An "about me" section (possibly the homepage) where you describe your cooking experience as well as any other relevant information your fans may want to know about you (Like age, favorite subjects in school, specialty dishes, Celebrity Chef you admire the most, etc). We can post your Casting video here too!
- A separate "Culinary Creations" page that runs a stream of photos of all of your food created both inside and outside of the classroom.
- A "contact me" page that links to your school email so your fans can send you fan mail and ask you any questions they may have.

WHAT DO I PUT IN EACH BLOG POST?

Describe the cooking techniques used in the lab (i.e. baking, broiling, sauteing, etc including which ingredients were cooked with which cooking techniques) (2 pts)

Identify the knife cuts and food item(s) using the knife cuts this lab *Type NA, if needed (1 pt) What was difficult about this lab? *complete sentences (2 points)

How did this lab reinforce what we learned in class (talk about how what we learned in class that helped you complete this lab) (5 points) *at least 5 complete sentences

What could you improve upon the next time you make this? (2 points) *complete sentences

TIP:

You do not have to type all of this all the time, if you would prefer to make a video explaining this information and posting it in the blog post that would be fine too!

Overall, this will be used to document your skills in the kitchen and how much you've improved throughout the filming of the show. You may want to use this portfolio in the future for many reasons, such as job interviews, college applications, and scholarship applications.
