RESEARCH

Why do you think those dishes gained popularity? Make sure you include a recipe for a dish from each country as well. Write a short summary of this information (1-2 pages double spaced)

WRITE A SONG OR RAP

Create a short song or rap about the different types of seafood and how to distinguish them from each other.

WRITTEN: 500 XP

VIDEO: 800 XP

GAME TIME

Create a unit review game using Kahoot, Quizizz, Quizlet, jeopardy, or another option that has been pre approved by Ms. Jarvis. Your game must include 20 questions/ terms.

RECIPE SKETCHNOTE

Create a recipe sketchnote of a recipe made during this unit. Turn in a copy of the original recipe along with your recipe sketchnote. Find examples of sketchnotes on papl.v.instructure.com

COMPARE & CONTRAST

Create a multiple venn diagram (3 circles) comparing and contrasting the characteristics of 3 categories of seafood of your choosing.

COMIC

Create a comic book page (either digitally using canva or by drawing it by hand) that explains the receiving guidelines for different types of seafood.

500 XP

SEAFOOD CUTS

Make an infographic explaining the different types of cuts of fish and how they can be purchased in a retail environment. Make sure to include signs to look for that the fish are fresh!

MAKE A TASTY VIDEO

Make a cooking video of you making a dish that features seafood. Whatever recipe choose must be made from scratch. Your video should include the (correct) measuring of ingredients, using mise en place, the steps of the recipe, and the final product.
